Harewood Suite

The spacious first floor Harewood Suite accommodates up to 220 guests, with the option of hightech sound-proofed screens to form smaller spaces for up to 80 and 40 guests respectively.

The original beams span the light and airy space, creating an inspirational and refreshing environment.

With inbuilt state-of-the-art technology the Harewood Suite is equipped for all modern corporate and meeting needs, including integral audio-visual facilities, high speed wireless internet connections ... and much more.

Gawthorpe Suite

The ground floor Gawthorpe Suite accommodates up to 120 guests standing or 60 seated.

The Gallery

Exclusive Tours - NEW

Exclusive tour and dining opportunities are now available of the first floor of Harewood House, known as the Private Apartments. It consists of numerous suites of rooms (including bedrooms, living areas and a dining room) that are used solely by the Lascelles family and their guests.

Until recently, these apartments were the primary residence of the Dowager Countess of Harewood and formerly her husband, George Lascelles, 7th Earl of Harewood, who had lived there together for over 40 years. The Private Apartments are now used by the current Earl and Countess and their family and are not open to the public.
